

Profile Theo van Iperen

Theo van Iperen (1965) is one of the leading consultants in the Netherlands in the field of organisational change. He is founder and owner of Giotto management consultants, a consultancy firm for strategic organisational changes. In 2000 he founded Giotto after having worked as a consultant at Bakkenist



Management Consultants, since 1999 a part of Deloitte. Van Iperen is specialised in supporting organisations during the implementation of fundamental changes such as mergers, reorganisations and take-overs. His customers can be found in both the profit and not-for-profit sectors in the Netherlands. Since 2000 Van Iperen has supported many change processes, mergers and other kinds of cooperation between organisations, for example in the public health sector, the education sector and the commercial sector.

Van Iperen studied Economics at Erasmus University Rotterdam and at the London School of Economics. Thereafter he successfully finished several postdoctoral studies in the field of financial management and management consultancy. Before he started as management consultant he worked at the Social and Economic Council of The Netherlands and as executive secretary at the University Hospital Leiden. In 2009 he wrote the book 'Fuseren is topsport' in which he brought together his experiences on mergers and created an efficient approach for managing mergers. Furthermore, he has written about 25 articles on organisational development and management. On a regular basis he is also asked as keynote speaker and visiting professor on these subjects. In 2011 Van Iperen was the winner of the prestigious "Professionaliseringsprijs" for management consultants from the VU University Amsterdam.

Theo van Iperen is married to Floor Stoutjesdijk and they have two daughters: Zara (2000) and Eefje (2003). Theo and his family live in Oegstgeest.
